The meeting convened at 2:30 pm.

The Park and Recreation Committee will depart the Terry Ashe Recreation Center at 2:40 p.m. to:

- 1. Tour selected District facilities for consideration of the possible installation of a pet memorial honoring animals lost in the 2018 Camp Fire; and**
- 2. Inspect completed and proposed improvements at these sites.**

Staff met with committee members and citizen participants at TARC, then traveled to Moore Rd Park and toured potential sites for a pet memorial and reviewed project work completed, in-progress, and pending at the park.

After the Moore Rd Park tour the group met at Bille Park and walked the site. Several potential sites were identified as favored for the pet memorial. Staff and committee members provided guidance to Gina Scheafer and Ellen Michels on process for approaching the full Board for consideration of the installation of a pet memorial at Bille Park.

The meeting adjourned at 4:35 pm.

I thank you for your consideration regarding a location for this memorial. I have reviewed the different sites that you proposed with our members. and the site near the pavilion, overlooking the ridge is the perfect home for this monument. (Pictures attached)

It is a peaceful, quiet place.

The tranquility in the atmosphere is perfectly appropriate, for those who come to grieve. Yet the whole area provides an invitation to them to return to this spot. The walking path is convenient access for anyone with physical disabilities, making less work for us to be ADA compliant. The nearby benches, grass and restrooms also make this space welcoming, and user-friendly for everybody.

But most importantly, the monument itself depicts the view of that very spot. It is a mirror-image in stone, of the living, breathing, nature that surrounds it.

There really is no perfect place for this memorial, except that spot.

*If, for some reason, that location is not an option, choice number two would in Bille Park also, near the pavilion but closer to the back entrance, on the left.

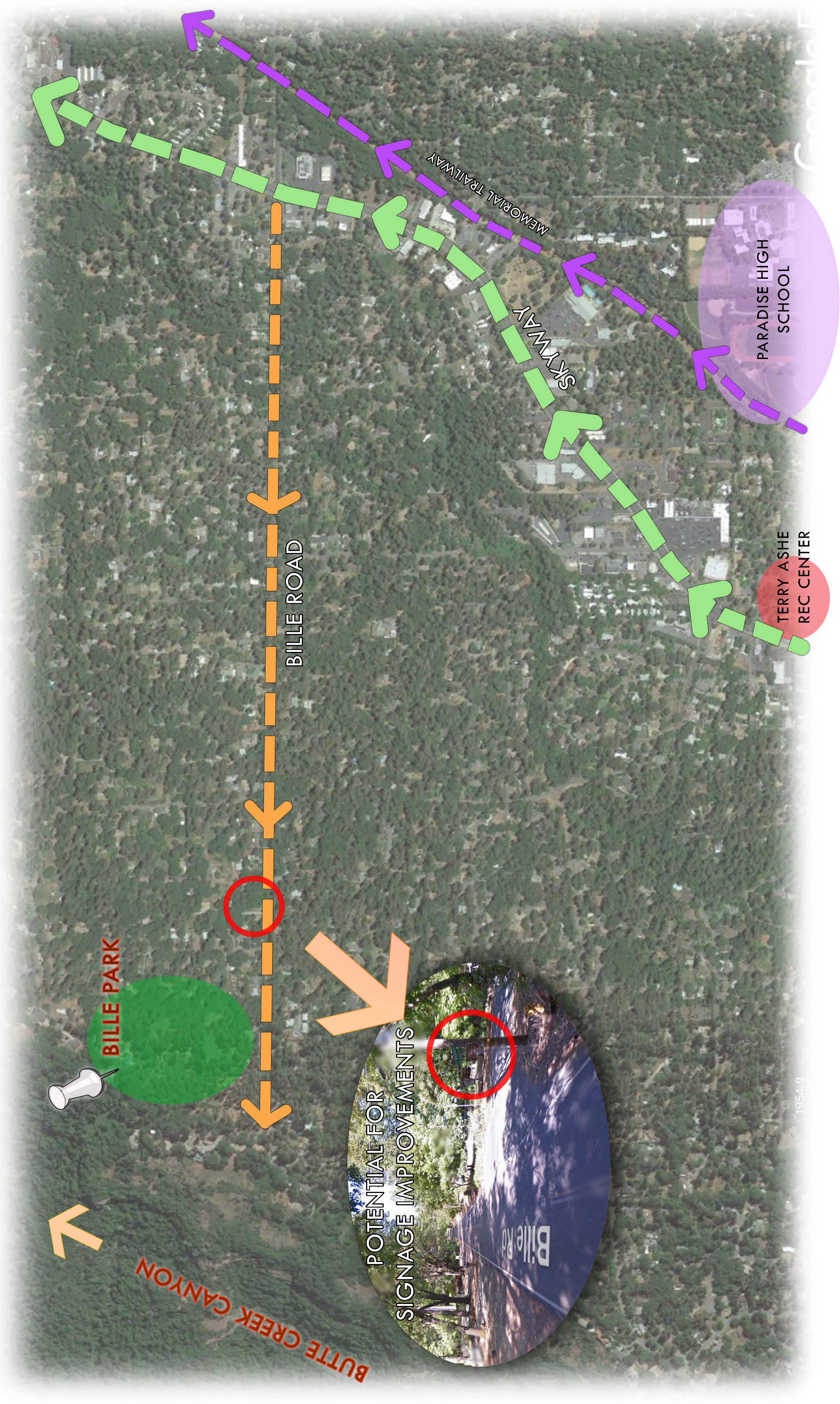
The third option, and less private, would be near the main entrance to Bille Park.

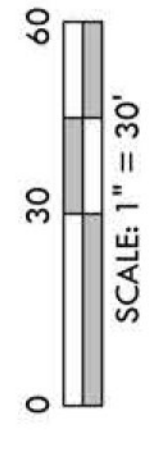
