


GRANITE:

CAMP FIRE PET AND WILDLIFE MEMORIAL

ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018, THE CAMP FIRE BROKE OUT IN THE EARLY MORNING HOURS. BY THE END OF THAT TRAGIC DAY, ALMOST 14,000 HOUSES WERE BURNED TO THE GROUND IN THE KNOTHILL COMMUNITIES OF BUTTE COUNTY.

THOUSANDS OF PETS, WORKING ANIMALS AND WILDLIFE EITHER PERISHED IN THE FIRE OR WERE NEVER FOUND.

THIS MONUMENT IS DEDICATED TO THOSE LOST THAT DAY OR THOSE THAT FOLLOWED. THEY MAY BE GONE FROM OUR VIEW, BUT THEY WILL NEVER LEAVE OUR HEARTS OR MEMORIES.




#4 REBAR MAT
